### Navigation

#### *Preliminaries*

This section contains the material preceding the table of contents in the hardbound version. It includes the cover page, title page, publication information, contributing authors' and editors' names and titles, and a list of other volumes in the TMM series.

To view this section, use the scroll bar located on the right-hand side of the document window or the arrow buttons located in the lower left-hand corner of the document window.

#### *Table of Contents*

This section is the table of contents.

To view this section, use the scroll bar on the right-hand side of the document window or the arrow buttons in the lower left-hand corner of the document window.

Blue text indicates a hyperlink to that part of the textbook. As you use your mouse to move the image of the hand to a hyperlink, the hand changes to a hand pointing and, upon clicking, will take you to the selected information in a separate file.

To navigate through individual chapters, use the blue hyperlinks to “jump” down to the selected section or scroll to the desired section by using the scroll bar at the right-hand side of the document window or the arrow buttons in the lower left-hand corner. To return to the beginning of the chapter, use the scroll bar or arrow keys.

To view tables and figures, click on the table or figure number in blue text. To go back to the chapter that referenced the table or figure, click on the blue text “[Back](#).”

*Note: Due to PDF design limitations, clicking on “Back” will take you to the beginning of the selected chapter. It will not return you to the same line where the hyperlink appeared.*

To return to the table of contents from a particular chapter, use the scroll bar or arrow buttons to go to the end of the chapter. Then click on “Return to Table of Contents.”
